

Health & Safety Induction

Welcome to Kalamunda Community Learning Centre (KCLC). KCLC has a legal responsibility under the Work Health and Safety legislation to keep you healthy and safe when you spend time at the Centre. This is important information you need to know when you become a member of this class.

Mosaics

Food and drink are not to be prepared in the craft room.

Always wear closed-in shoes.

Keep the workspace orderly so that tools, pieces of cut tile, and glass don't fall onto the floor and become a hazard.

It is recommended to wear light weight gloves when crafting mosaics. This helps protect nails/skin form harsh materials e.g. tiles

When cutting tiles/glass... please wear safety glasses OR cut with a cloth covering your work.

When handling/mixing grout, ALWAYS wear a mask and gloves. Grout is a harsh product,

Left over grout can be tightly wrapped in newspaper and placed in the appropriate rubbish bin

NEVER pour water that has grout in it down the sink. Dilute grout that remains in the mixing container/bucket with water after completing step above. Dispose of it in nearby bush OR garden.

Be alert, stay safe and enjoy your mosaic sessions at KCLC.

There is a first aid kit in the craft room, fire extinguisher, fire blanket and spill kit.
